By signing this contract, the purchaser acknowledges that he/she is aware and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

### **Payment**

The sale price for a puppy from Honeysweet Goldens under AKC Limited registration is Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (5,500 USD). The deposit of \$500 was received on or before the puppies visiting day (6 weeks old of the puppies). The remaining balance of \$5,000 was received on or before the puppy pick up day.

### **Registration**

The puppy with Registration # \_\_\_\_\_ is limited registered with AKC as Honeysweet's.

The buyer paid the breeder \$30 to have the dog registered. The dog is registered to the buyer's name directly.

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The \$30 AKC registration fee is non refundable. The AKC registration is part of the dog's ownership. In the event of the returning of the dog, the registration paper must be surrendered.

### Microchip

Per the buyer's request, the breeder implanted a microchip to the puppy. The microchip number is .

The breeder charged the buyer \$25 to have the dog microchipped and registered with AKC lifetime Reunited lost and found service.

The Microchip fee is not refundable. The microchip indicates the ownership of the dog. In the event of the returning of the dog, the microchip registration must be transferred back to the breeder.

### Health Clarification and Guarantee

The breeder guarantees the puppy is healthy at the time of sale. On , , Touchstone Veterinary Center, 382 Hwy 79, Morganville, NJ, 07751, gave the puppy a routine examination to guarantee that it is in good health at the time of sale.

The puppy is vaccinated with Nobivac Puppy DPv combo Vaccine. The buyer will receive a copy of the puppy's medical record along with its immunization history at the time of sale. It is the buyer's responsibility to re-examine the puppy routinely, follow the vet's advice and give the dog proper care. The breeder will not assume any liability for veterinary expenses, medical bills, or travel expenses incurred by the buyer.

Within the first Three (3) days of the date of sale, if the buyer's veterinarian finds any significant concern with the puppy that originated with the breeder, the buyer should contact the breeder and demand a full refund from the breeder. To make such return, the buyer must immediately notify the breeder along with the name, contact number of the attending

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veterinarian, and the illness or the condition of the dog. The buyer must forward the breeder a letter signed by the examining veterinarian indicating the nature of the puppy's illness or condition that originated with the breeder. The buyer must also give the vet permission to fully disclose the puppy's health situation to the breeder.

Golden Retrievers are knowingly prone to hip and elbow dysplasia, hereditary eye disease, hereditary heart disease and a variety of debilitating health disorders. The breeder has taken reasonable precautions to prevent this puppy from developing many other hereditary diseases. Unfortunately the hereditary and environmental causes of many diseases are not fully known. Notwithstanding the efforts of breeder, the breeder cannot guarantee that the puppy will be free of inherited genetic or other disease.

The breeder guarantees to the best of their knowledge, that the puppy's parents are free of inherited genetic disease or disorders. The sire and dam of the puppy were examined by board certified veterinarians and considered clear of debilitating diseases at the time of breeding including hereditary elbow, hip, eye and heart defects. DNA and thyroid testing completed before the sire and dam were bred show no adverse results.

If the purchased dog is diagnosed with a proven inherited, genetic defect of the hips, eyes or heart within its first Twelve (12) months of life, the buyer may request a refund of no more than 50% of the original purchase price of the dog. The breeder will honor a refund within six (6) months of confirmation of the diagnosis upon all of the following terms being met:

1. The illness or the condition of the dog must be a proven inherited genetic defect; and
2. The buyer must notify the breeder promptly after a proven inherited genetic defect is diagnosed; and
3. A written document of the diagnosis of such medical condition from an appropriate governing body must be provided. An appropriate governing body can be OFA or PennHip or a licensed ophthalmologist or a board certified ACVIM cardiologist. An examination by a licensed Veterinary of general practitioner alone is not sufficient for a refund request, and will not be accepted; and,

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4. The buyer must consult a specialist before making any surgery or major decisions; and
5. The buyer must inform the breeder before any surgery takes place; and
6. The buyer must follow Dr Jean Dodd's vaccination schedule;
7. The buyer must meet all terms and conditions in the Pet Puppy Sale Contract; and
8. Medical bills must be provided; and
9. A necropsy report must be provided in the was dead; and
10. The diagnostic costs will not count as part of the medical bill and will not be covered by this health guarantee; and
11. The refund amount will not exceed the amount of the medical spending on the said condition; and
12. The amount of the refund total will be no more than 50% of the original purchase price of the dog.

We gave each puppy a temperament test at 6-7 weeks of age to assess behavioral traits and aptitude by using the Volhard P.A.T. The buyer must contact the breeder promptly if s/he has questions about the temperament or behavior of this puppy. However, notwithstanding the efforts of the breeder, the purchaser must understand and acknowledge that the breeder can not predetermine the outcome of the breeding and therefore can make no assurances that the puppy will meet the purchaser's expectations with respect to conformation, performance, or temperament.

### **Non-Breeding and Spay/Neuter Agreement**

Our puppies, if no other written agreement were made, are sold as family pets and companions. The Purchaser agrees that s/he is purchasing the puppy on an American Kennel Club, and/or United Kennel Club non-breeding agreement and that this dog is not considered to be a breeding stock. All AKC, UKC and private non-breeding agreements will remain in effect for the life of the dog and will not be canceled, if there is no other written agreement made.

The buyer agrees to compensate the breeder TEN Thousand US Dollars (10,000 USD) Per Litter if this Non-Breeding agreement is breached. Use of the said dog in any breeding activity (accidentally, naturally or

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artificially, purposely) will be considered as a breach to this Non- Breeding agreement.

The buyer agrees to spay/neuter the puppy between Eighteen (18) and Twenty-Four (24) months of age, and forward a copy of the Spay/neuter certificate to the breeder. Early spay or neutering, before Twelve (12) months of age, may cause health issues.

Failure to meet the Spay/Neuter agreement terms will dissolve and forfeit the health guarantee.

### **Puppy Care Agreement**

The Purchaser agrees to provide the puppy responsible care, necessary socialization and training, reasonable amount of exercise, well balanced nutrition, fresh water, indoor shelter, adequate grooming, and competent veterinary care to ensure the overall wellbeing of this dog.

Overfeeding a Golden Retriever is the leading cause of hip dysplasia for a puppy that is otherwise not genetically predisposed to the disease. The ideal adult Female Golden Retriever weight is 55-65 lbs.; and the ideal adult Male Golden should be 65-75 lbs. The breeder's health guarantee only applies to the dogs that have been maintained in good physical condition. The health guarantee does not cover obese, improperly exercised or injured dogs. Nether will it cover dogs with an improper diet, or dogs with poor muscle tone.

For the health guarantee to remain valid, a monthly record of the dog's weight gain must be maintained by a veterinarian for the first year of the dog's life. Thereafter, the weight is required to be recorded every 3 months until 2 years of age.

The record of up to date immunizations (including but not limited to proper vaccinations, de-wormers, tick, flea, and heartworm medication) is required to validate the health guarantee. Please be aware of the side effects of the vaccinations and the medications you are going to use on the dog. The buyer is recommended to use a holistic veterinarian.

For the health guarantee to remain valid, the owner must follow Dr Jean Dodd's Vaccination protocol, which is adopted by all 27 vet schools in North America. A hard copy of Dr Jean Dodd's Vaccination Schedule is.

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printed out and provided alone this contract. The buyer agrees not to use any internal Flea and Tick Prevention medication on this dog.

The Buyer agrees s/he will not knowingly endanger the dog. This dog will not be crated, chained or tied outdoors. The buyer agrees that the dog will not be exposed to other animals whose vaccination history is unknown, or to areas that may be frequented by them. The buyer agrees no prong chain will be used on this dog.

All Honeysweet Goldens on the breeder's procession are on a balanced diet with NuVet Plus daily vitamin, probiotics, goat milk, Phyto Flex and apple cider vinegar. The buyer is welcome to consult with the breeder. However, it is the buyer's responsibility to find a well-balanced nutrition diet plan that fits the needs of his/her dog.

Improper grooming can be harmful to a Golden Retriever's health mentally and/or physically. We strongly suggest the buyer does not shave her/his Golden if there is no medical necessity.

It is strongly recommended that the buyer enroll her/his dog in a socializing class and basic obedience class after it has received proper immunizations.

### **Change in Contact Acknowledgement Agreement**

The buyer agrees to acknowledge the breeder if their contact information is changed in a timely manner.

### **Change in Circumstances Agreement**

If the Buyer can no longer keep the purchased dog for any reason, the breeder reserves the right to take the dog back at no cost to either party. The AKC, and/or UKC registration must be surrendered to the breeder at that time. The medical history and the immunization record of the dog must be supplied as well.

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The buyer agrees to compensate the breeder Five Thousand US Dollar (\$5,000) if s/he is transferring the dog to a third party without the breeder's written consent.

### **The Trial Insurance Disclosure**

The breeder is not liable to supply any pet insurance to the buyer. There is a 30-day trial AKC pet insurance if the buyer registers the dog with AKC. It is the buyer's responsibility to register with any pet insurer(s) ! make the payment, and follow its/their terms and conditions to receive its/their benefit. The buyer is urged to maintain a good pet insurance policy for the life of this dog.

## KNOW YOUR RIGHT STATEMENT OF NEW JERSEY LAW A STATEMENT OF NEW JERSEY LAW GOVERNING THE SALE OF DOGS AND CATS

The sale of dogs and cats is subject to a regulation of the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs. In the event that a licensed veterinarian certifies your animal to be unfit for purchase within 14 days following receipt of your animal or within six months in the case of a congenital or hereditary cause or condition, you may:

- i) Return your animal and receive a refund of the purchase price including sales tax; or
- ii) Keep your animal and attempt to cure it; or
- iii) Return your animal and receive an animal of your choice of equivalent value.

Veterinary fees limited to two times the purchase price of the animal, including sales tax, which were related to the condition rendering the animal unfit for sale, must be paid by the dealer in the event that you choose to keep the animal. If you choose to return the animal, veterinary fees incurred prior to receipt of the veterinary certification, limited to two times the purchaser price of the animal, including sales tax, which were related to the condition rendering the animal unfit for sale, must be paid by the dealer.

Further, in the event of your animal's death within this 14-day period, except when death occurs by accident or as a result of injuries sustained after delivery, you may choose to receive either a full refund of the purchase price, plus sales tax, or an animal of equivalent value. In addition, veterinary fees, limited to two times the purchase price, including sales tax must be paid by the pet dealer.

In order to exercise these rights, you must present to the pet dealer a written veterinary certification that the animal is unfit for purchase and an itemized bill of all veterinary fees incurred prior to your receipt of the certification. Both of these items must be presented no later than five days after you have received the certification of unfitness. In the event that the pet dealer wishes to contest certification or the bill, he may request a hearing at the Division of Consumer Affairs.

If the pet dealer does not contest the matter, he must make the refund or reimbursement not later than ten days after receiving the veterinary certification. Although your dog or cat is required to be examined by a licensed veterinarian prior to sale, symptoms of certain conditions may not appear until after sale. If your dog or cat appears ill, you should have it examined by a licensed veterinarian of your choice at the earliest possible time. If the pet dealer has promised to register your animal or to provide the necessary papers and fails to do so within the 120 days following the date of sale, you are entitled to return the animal and receive a full refund of the purchase price plus sales tax or to keep the animal and receive a refund of 75 percent of the purchase price plus sales tax. In the event you elect to keep the animal and the dealer provides the 75 percent refund, the dealer is no longer obligated to register the animal or to provide the necessary papers to do so.
